

Vocational education and training (VET) is nationally accredited training that gives students skills and knowledge for work. VET courses enable students to:

- personalise their learning pathway
- gain specific competencies in an industry area
- work towards gaining accredited certification
- work towards achieving their SACE whilst undertaking learning in a vocational environment.

NORTH EAST VOCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES (NEVO)

Banksia Park International High School is part of the NEVO partnership, comprising of schools from the north eastern suburbs, to provide a wide range of VET pathways for students.

Students from BPIHS can enroll in a VET course offered through another NEVO school.

Students are enrolled at BPIHS but attend a host school or Registered Training Organisation (RTO) to complete a VET course of their choice.

VET 2022

Due to changes in the structure of VET in schools, the available courses and costs will be distributed to students when this information is confirmed and available.

For 2022, VET will be offered to BPIHS students who are going to be in year 11 in 2022. This is due to a change in length of courses (most run for 18 months to 2 years), and due to changes in requirements with year 11 being the first year students are eligible to undertake a Certificate level course.
