STUDENT LEARNING

Year 7s joining us in 2026 will become part of our junior sub-school where we focus on empowering students to become confident, critical and creative thinkers. Learning activities and assessments are aligned to the Australian Curriculum with a focus on the development of skills, knowledge and learning dispositions.

Students engage in learning through English, Humanities and Social Sciences, The Arts, Science, Mathematics, Technologies, Languages, and Health and Physical Education. Interdisciplinary learning occurs through relevant and meaningful topics and inquiry into issues and ideas of local and global significance.

In the middle and senior sub-schools, we develop independent learners who are responsible and accountable for their learning and achievements. Students select from an extensive range of subjects, vocational education and training pathways and community-based learning, enabling all students to follow their strengths, passions, and interests for future pathways.

Our classrooms are innovative, flexible spaces that support our students to be self-directed, to take responsibility for

their learning, partner with our staff, and work collaboratively. Our school has exceptional resources and facilities, creating ideal learning environments where students thrive.

STUDENT LIFE

Young people and their learning are at the heart of everything we do. Our Student Life programs are specially designed to cater for each year level and provide students with a focused exploration of learning, wellbeing and career education, and global/digital citizenship. The programs influence and guide students' academic and personal development. School values, goal setting, growth mind set, study habits, work experience, driving and being safe, responsible use of technology, wellbeing, pathway and career planning are all part of our year 7 - 12 Student Life program.

SPECIAL ENTRY FUTURE ACADEMY PROGRAM

This selective entry program is available to students entering year 7, which provides an entrepreneurial pathway through to year 12. Developing key skills and entrepreneurial capabilities highlighted by society and industry are the focus of this specialist program. Students in the program are supported to define and pursue their own learning by working with communities, industries and universities to become agents of innovation, renewal, and growth.

Special entry for this program is based on a selection process available to students both in and out of zone. Further information can be found on our website.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR

We recognise that students learn, develop and grow through their involvement and participation in common interest activities. Our student-led extra-curricular activities challenge and complement student learning and encourage school pride.

There are many opportunities for students to develop their leadership through school, community and international forums. Leadership opportunities are present in year levels, learning areas, sub-schools, and in the school's house system, as well as for a cohort of year 10 Emerging Leaders.

Students with musical interests can participate in the stage band, concert band, ensembles and vocal groups.

The school has a strong sporting tradition and is actively involved in interschool and state competitions and carnivals throughout the year in numerous sports. We also have a Specialist Soccer program.

Students can also get involved by joining a group or club in activities including art, dungeons & dragons, entrepreneurialism, international, robotics, reading ambassadors and sustainability.
