



Consent for Chief Executive Approved Early Dismissals

The Chief Executive has determined that early dismissal of students in government schools can be provided up to 1 hour before the normal end of the school day:

- on the last school day before the Easter long weekend
- no more than 4 times a year for the purpose of the end of school terms
- for the purpose of an annual school sports day
- for the purpose of an annual district-wide sport carnival; and
- in the event of an extreme heatwave declared by the State Emergency Services, or where the health and safety of the children at the school are considered at risk due to the absence, localised failure or poor performance of air conditioning on days of extreme heat (36 degrees or above).

Parents will be notified in advance (minimum 1 month) of the reason, time and date of the above early dismissals through the normal communication channels used between the school and parents, including, but not limited to, school newsletters and the school's website.

For early dismissals relating to 'extreme heat' scenarios parents will be notified as soon as possible before students are dismissed.

*The Governing Council has also endorsed an early dismissal for the school's annual Twilight Evening, where all current and prospective families are welcome to visit the school to meet, greet, and engage with student learning activities. Dismissal will be at 2:10 pm.
